

 Dr. Zielke is the Patricia Valian Reser Professor of Music at Oregon State University, where he also serves as director of choral studies and associate director in the School of Arts and Communication. He earned his doctoral and master's degrees in choral conducting from The Florida State University and held the prestigious Clayton Krehbiel Fellowship, funded through the generous efforts of the late Robert Shaw.



Associate Conductor Raymund Ocampo
 Mr. Ocampo received a master's in choral conducting from the University of South Florida and served as the Bonita L. Bass Memorial assistant conductor for the Master Chorale of Tampa Bay. He received his bachelor's in music education from Concordia College where he studied with Dr. René Clausen and Dr. Paul Nesheim. He currently serves as music program chair and director of choral studies at Linn Benton Community College.

Beautiful, haunting, ethereal, searching, uplifting, earthy and majestic, are words that aptly describe this contemporary work by Welsh composer Karl Jenkins. Known for his blending of symphonic and World Music elements with a large chorus, Jenkins features texts from Gandhi, Martin Luther King, the Dalai Lama, Nelson Mandela, Anne Frank and Mother Teresa, as well as words from the Bible, the Qur’an, and special text from author and humanitarian, Terry Waite. *The Peacemakers* is a massive work extolling peace as a healing and reconciling force. Maestro Zielke will present a pre-concert talk on this work.


